Programs should be strictly enforcing the guidelines below with regard to child and/or staff reentry following illness or exposure:

- If the child or staff member has been *exposed* to an individual who is COVID-19 positive or presumed to be
 - COVID-19 positive, then they may not return to childcare for 14 days.
- If the child has *symptoms but not otherwise exposed* to an individual who is COVID-19 positive or presumed to be COVID-19 positive, they may not return to childcare until the symptoms abate.
